This year's [Architectural Digest Design Show](#) in New York saw a record turnout with more than 400 brands showcasing the latest in furniture, lighting, and accessories, along with state-of-the-art kitchen appliances, bath fixtures, and flooring. The fair, which ran from March 21 through March 24, also featured some 170 artists and designers as well as more than 50 women-owned or -led companies—the largest representation in the 18-year history of the show.
