Founded by Atlanta-based interior designer Emily Painter and her husband Austin, the company specializes in mix-and-match table linens and accessories with a distinct vacation-ready vibe. Think block-prints from brands like Marigold Living and Penny Morrison, scalloped raffia placemats by Blue Pheasant, and vintage florals from D'Ascoli. The standard rental period lasts four days (Freshly Set advises scheduling delivery for a day or two before your event just in case), and when you're done with your linens, just pack them up and slap on the prepaid label—they'll take care of the rest.

Cost: \$22 to \$65 for a tablecloth, \$2.50 to \$6 per napkin.
